Title: Differences between the recommended and real dose in a smoking cessation practice

Body: Aims:To analyze the dose and time decided by the patient regarding what is recommended and its influence on the tobacco cessation rate. Methods: We included patients who attended our practice during the last 6 months.We analyzed several variables:recommended dose(varenicline(V):0.5/1mgrs,2 months;bupropion(B):150 mgrs/day,2 months),real dose and duration of the treatment,tobacco cessation rates and causes of early abandonment of medication. Results: n=312 patients:V(56%) and B(44%).By comparing both groups,we couldn't find differences regarding cessation rate after 3 (V:64.4%/B:67.2%) or 6 months (V:64.2%/B: 67.2%).We realized the patients followed the recommended dose (V:82.3%/B:94.2%,p=0.001).Cessation rates are shown in figure 1.

Regarding the duration of treatment:V:6.6±1.6/B:7.9±0.7,p<0.001.Cessation rates after 6 months:V:96%vs51.2%/B:95.7%vs6.8%;p<0.001.Causes of medication abandonment are shown in table 1.

Conclusions: Using 2 month treatments and half the recommended dose of B,cessation rates are good

>64%.Below 5 week treatments are clearly insufficient with B as well as V.Causes of early abandonment of medication were mainly due to economic and psychological reasons.
